From the organization of CITZARAGOZA2017 we are pleased to welcome you to the Congress of the next days 8, 9 and 10 of December.

Taking advantage of this opportunity, we wanted to give the congress an educational profile in a broad sense and, specifically, addressing the theme of mentoring in musicians.

For this reason, different conferences, round tables and workshops have been organized that address different generic concepts in general education, as well as that of the musician and horn player in particular.

Starting from the premise of the support of the families in the general education and of the horn player in particular as a necessary condition for the successful development of the student, we want to show that the programming of all the conferences, round tables and workshops (besides concerts and rest of activities) are aimed at the families of the horn players participating directly and actively in them.

Therefore, from the organization we encourage families to participate actively in the activities of the Congress, this being one of the main reasons for choosing the theme of mentoring musicians in this year's congress.

- Identification: on Friday, 8 after the reception, an identification card will be given to each congressman that will allow access to the Conservatory of Music of Aragon (CSMA), headquarters of the CITZARAGOZA2017.

The families of the congressmen will also be able to access the access control personnel as relatives of Congressmen.

- Meeting Point (Meeting Point): In the hall there will be a meeting point with permanent staff to be able to report any doubts. It will also be the point at which any minor congressman who may have missed at some point in the congress will have to go.

- Information on points of interest of the City of Zaragoza by the Zaragoza City Council: On Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. there will be a stand in the CSMA Hall of Zaragoza City Hall to inform of different points of interest of the city. city.

- Active congressmen. Choice of activities. Priorities:

As a general rule, the congressmen are the ones who will decide the choice of the activities they wish to attend.

• Ensembles Elemental and Professional Teachings: In a few days you will receive by e-mail the sheet music of the ensembles so that you can prepare them the days before the congress.

Since a concert is scheduled on Sunday at 10:15 in the CSMA for these ensembles, from the organization it is requested that the congressmen give priority to the programmed trials of the ensembles (otherwise, it would not be possible to realize the concert of the Sunday , 10).

- *Individual classes: To access the individual classes scheduled, the student must go to the classroom of the teacher in which he is interested to receive the class and arrange time and day with him (the schedule of the master classes of Marie Luise Neunecker and David Cooper and they are assigned from the organization).*

If the agreed time coincides with one of the ensembles rehearsals, the student can then give priority to the individual class by notifying the ensemble teacher that he has been assigned when he will be absent.

The same criteria will apply in the case of students participating in the contest or any other activity to which they wish to give priority over the ensembles.

- Meals in the CSMA: The congressmen who have reserved food to the organization to eat in the CSMA should go to the staff located from 13 to 15 h. in the CSMA cafeteria (in the Center Hall). There they must request identifying the ticket with which they will be able to pay for the food in the cafeteria.

The rest of people who have not reserved food to the organization must pay the amount (12 euros) directly in the cafeteria.

Food shifts: There will be two meal shifts:

1:00 pm: For students of elementary education, professionals.

2:00 pm: For students of higher education and teachers.
